Credit Unions Put Finishing Touches on Specially Adapted Home

Columbia – Missouri credit unions put the finishing touches on a specially adapted home for Army Staff Sergeant (SSG) Robert Canine on June 19, as part of a credit union volunteer day for the first Homes for Our Troops project in Missouri. More than 40 credit union staff, family and friends volunteered to landscape the lot. Volunteers rolled sod and planted trees, bushes and flowers.

“My wife likes to garden and her brother is serving in Afghanistan, so this hits close to home,” says Bill Mustain, Employment Security Credit Union. “We’re happy to support this cause.”

Missouri credit unions sponsored the project for Homes for Our Troops, raising \$100,000 to help build the home for SSG Canine and his family. A native of Mexico, Missouri, Canine lost both of his legs below the knee while serving in Iraq. The home is specially adapted to his needs.

Credit unions participating in the June 19 volunteer day included Alliance Credit Union (Fenton), Anheuser-Busch Employees’ Credit Union (St. Louis), Employment Security Credit Union (Jefferson City), River Region Credit Union (Jefferson City), Rolla Federal Credit Union, United Credit Union (Mexico) and the Missouri Credit Union Association.

“Missouri credit unions are so grateful to Robert for his sacrifice, and we feel privileged to work with Homes for Our Troops to make this family’s home a reality,” says Rosie Holub, Missouri Credit Union Association president/CEO. “The hard work is worth it, and we are anxious to see the Canine family settled in their new home so they can move forward with their lives.”
